

# **“Inside Emily Dickinson: Her Poetry & Her Life”**

## **Library Version Set Up Needs**

### **Set Requirements:**

1. 2 library tables (placed on either side of the performance area)
2. 5 library chairs  
(Ms. Grace will help arrange tables & chairs upon arrival)
3. 1 Easel w/Easel Pad & Markers
4. Audience chairs should be arranged with a ‘slight curve’ around the playing space (at least with the front rows) if this is possible. This will give more a feeling that “Emily is in the midst of everyone there,” and is very appropriate to this piece. Ms. Grace can help finesse the seating arrangement, as she will arrive at the Library early to work with the performance arrangement and warm up for the show.

### **Sound:**

**IF Space Demands that Ms. Grace use a body mike**, this will be supplied by the library and hook into the Library Amplifiers and speakers to reinforce sound quality of Ms. Grace.
